The following is a brief update on events/issues that will be of concern to you this term.

New classroom: The Board of Management are delighted to announce that the Department of Education and Skills have agreed to fund a new classroom which will be used for support group-teaching and ICT. It is hoped that this build will commence in spring 2020.

Digital Learning; The school has just purchased 25 new iPads which will be used by all classes to develop digital learning in our school.
