School Self-Evaluation 2024-'25


Maths: In September a new maths curriculum was introduced throughout the school. This curriculum is characterised by playfulness, creativity, challenge, risk-taking, collaboration and opportunities for reasoning and solving real-life problems. In this new curriculum, children must understand why math works and how different areas of math are related


Wellbeing Policy: Pupil wellbeing is an area we are continuing to focus on. The school has invested in upgrading facilities in the playground so that children have a variety of play opportunities. We have a installed a climbing wall, basketball hoops and games boards at the junior end. A new picnic bench has been put into the senior yard. Our student council take turns in helping others on the yard who might be finding it hard to join in games. This year our school provided a counselling programme for pupils with anxiety. We also had a very enjoyable and successful wellbeing week in school in April.

Literacy: In 2024-25, the focus of our School Self-Evaluation in Literacy was in the area of **Comprehension development**. The school has invested in resources for all classes to enable teachers develop and embed comprehension skills as part of this plan. We will implement our school improvement plan for comprehension in September.

Standardised Tests 2025

Literacy & Numeracy: Standardised testing (Drumcondra Literacy, Maths, Irish and Spellings) have been carried out in all upper classes and the school is performing well. Screening tests have been undertaken in the Junior and Senior Infant Classes. Please see graphs below showing how Bekan School is performing against the national norms for literacy and numeracy.
